### Israel Comes In Second

Israel was ranked number two, Iraq listed as number 1, on a list of countries that threaten world peace, according to a recent survey conducted by French newspapers in northwest France, which have a combined readership of about 175,000.

The list includes a total of 15 countries. Following Iraq and Israel were Afghanistan, the United States, Palestine, Iran, Pakistan, Algiers and Libya in that order. Syria appears number 12 on the list.

In these instances, despite the fact that there were Arab demands and American pressure, when the Arabs saw that Israel was firm and would not compromise on these issues, they were removed from the agenda.

### Another Miracle

Thursday morning, a crowded No. 87 bus stopped to pick up passengers on the Geha Highway opposite Bar-Ilan University, when an Arab passenger trying to board through the back door slipped and fell outside. As the bus pulled away, several passengers yelled to the driver that someone had fallen. He stopped the bus, and together with another man went to attend to the fallen would-be passenger - and then caught a glimpse of wires wrapped around the Arab's body, and realized he was a suicide bomber wearing an explosives belt.

They quickly grabbed the murderer's arms to prevent him from detonating the device, and yelled to the passengers to get off the bus. Then they let go of the terrorist and started running. Seconds later, the bomber got up, ran about 30 meters towards a group of people and detonated his explosives - killing Saadah Aharon, 71, of Ramat Gan, and wounding 11 others. Mrs. Aharon is survived by 3 children and 15 grandchildren.

Police say that the powerful explosive, which contained metal balls, would have been catastrophic had it been detonated on board the bus.

## STUFF you should know

### Bin Laden Who? It Is Only A Jew!

Osama bin Laden helped pay for the legal defense of the man who shot Jewish leader Meir Kahane in a New York hotel in 1990, officials revealed Tuesday.

The FBI had never heard of bin Laden at the time, and the New York police were saying Kahane's killing by El Sayed A Nosair, was the work of a lone gunman with no affiliation to terrorist groups.

The revelation surfaced in a report by Eleanor Hill, director of the Senate Intelligence Committee that is investigating pre-September 11 intelligence failures by government agencies. Nosair gunned down Kahane after a speech in a midtown Manhattan hotel in November 1990. Nosair was first charged in state court and went on trial in early 1991 in Manhattan Supreme Court. During that trial, the FBI learned that one of his relatives "traveled to Saudi Arabia to obtain money to pay for Nosair's defense," Hill wrote. "He received funds from a wealthy Saudi -- Osama Bin Laden," Hill wrote. At the time, an FBI agent handling the Nosair case told the Senate investigators, "this was the first time the FBI's New York office heard bin Laden's name."

Nosair was acquitted in the Kahane murder but convicted of a gun charge. He was later found guilty of the murder in federal court.
