The week in review

No Work Accident

An Arab terrorist disguised as a worker, opened fire at several Jews near the community of Pe'at Sadeh murdering two. Security forces had received intelligence warnings of a likely terrorist attack. The entering Arab workers were searched for weapons twice when they arrived in the morning. It was to no avail, however, because after passing inspection, the terrorist quickly went to where he had hidden a weapon on a previous occasion, and opened fire. He murdered Amos Saada, 52, and Assaf Tzafirah, 18, son of the terrorist's Jewish employer. The town's security officer arrived within a few minutes and killed the Hamas terrorist, but not before being slightly wounded himself.

P.A.'s Educational TV

PA's Broadcasting Corp. has come under attack from an unexpected direction. Meretz, Knesset Member Ran Cohen. He went as far as asking the Communications Minister to recall the license granted by Israel to the PA (1994) that allows the PBC free access to airwave transmissions in Israel.

Cohen was infuriated by a recent study conducted by Dr. Bechor of children's programs on PBC. The study tracks "consistent trend of the PBC since its inception in 1994 to indoctrinate a generation of children to commit suicide attacks and to make war on the Jews and the Zionist entity."

After eight years of PBC's incitement, Cohen said the time has come to admit that neglecting the issue of official PA incitement was the greatest mistake made by the late PM Yitzhak Rabin. "Rabin thought we should deal with this kind of thing after everything else was solved," Cohen said "we now know that Rabin was wrong. Rabin made a mistake, and there is no reason to repeat that mistake."

Paying The Ultimate Price

Julio Magre, 51, who immigrated this year from Argentina, was the guard who bodily prevented an Arab suicide terrorist from entering the crowded mall in Kfar Saba and paid with his life. Also Killed was a 14-year-old youth. The guard identified the Arab as a terrorist, and ran towards him while yelling, "Terrorist, terrorist, everyone run!" When he reached the murderer, he stopped him from advancing into the mall - and at that point the murderer detonated the bomb.

Target Assassinations ?

Sunday, an unmanned U.S. spy plane successfully fired a bomb at a car in Yemen, killing six suspected Al-Qaeda terrorists, including one of the main suspects in the bombing of the U.S.S. Cole two years ago.

U.S. Deputy Defense Secretary Wolfowitz called the attack on the car "a very successful tactical operation" that was designed not only to get "rid of somebody dangerous, but to impose changes in the enemy's tactics and operations." Concerned reporters from foreign news sources, such as Reuters and BBC (not generally known for their pro-Israel view), asked State Dept. spokesman Boucher how the attack squares with American objections to Israeli targeted killings of known murderous Palestinian terrorists. He replied that it was a question of "different circumstances," including "the [Middle East's] prospects of peace, prospects of negotiation and the prospects of the need to create an atmosphere for progress." Reuters described the answer as giving "the US room to try to justify the killing of six men in a car in Yemen," while BBC reported that US officials "now face some awkward questions about their opposition to Israeli actions."

Boucher said again that the U.S. policy of objecting to Israel's "targeted killings in the Israeli-Palestinian context has not changed."
