### Nineteen Years In A Coma

IDF Sergeant Major Nadal Fero of Osfiya died on Sunday after being in a coma for almost 19 years. Fero, who served in a fighting unit in the Gaza Strip, was injured during a skirmish with terrorists in April 1984 when he sustained massive internal injuries

### Off The Map

The company web site for the Middle East branch of Samsung Electronics contains a map that omits the name of Israel, and instead labels the area as "Palestine." The South Korean firm, which is the largest memory-chip maker and number 3 mobile-handset maker in the world, also lists sales and service locations throughout the region in places such as Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon and Syria. However, Israel is not listed.

### Road Safety

A nine-year-old boy, Dvir Nissan ben [son of] Esther, is in serious condition after being shot Wednesday by terrorists, as he was being driven home. He was in a car with his mother on his way to Ofrah when terrorists sprayed the vehicle with automatic weapons fire, and a bullet hit him in or close to the spine. Though still under sedation, he has moved his legs slightly, and his life is not endangered. The driver of the car, Yaakov Shteinmetz of Maaleh Levonah, is listed in moderate condition.

Four Israelis have been murdered during the ongoing Oslo War in the same area as that attack. The most recent victim was Albert Maloul of Jerusalem, who was killed eight months ago; the others were the Kahane couple - Binyamin and Talia - and Assaf Hershkovitz. At least another four shootings occurred there in the past months, and in fact an IDF outpost was stationed there to add protection.

Binyamin Regional Council head Pinchas Wallerstein said, however, that there must be a sterile area of 100-150 meters on both sides of the highway, near the two adjoining Arab villages: "Whoever enters that zone must be considered suspicious. The Arab residents will simply have to pay the price of not traveling in this area."

## STUFF you should know

### Getting Back The Guns

Over the past 2 months, 19 Jews from the Chevron area, were murdered by Arabs using guns (not suicide-bombers). One third of all Oslo victims have been murdered by Arabs using the Oslo-guns.

A high-ranking officer in the IDF revealed that a reserve division stationed in the Ramallah area during "Operation Defensive Shield", gathered weapons by going from house to house, and conducting thorough searches. These homes were not of wanted terrorists, rather homes of so-called "innocent peaceful Arab population". He said that in almost every Arab home they found guns. 1500 guns were gathered, within a few days, which is more than the entire IDF has gathered since the beginning of the Oslo war.

According to the Shabak, at the outbreak of the Oslo war in September 2000, there were more than 40,000 guns held by Arabs in Judea, Samaria and Gaza, of which 12,000 were given to the terrorists officially as part of the Oslo agreements. The rest were smuggled in or stolen under the new conditions created and facilitated by the Oslo agreements. To date, the IDF, in all of its activities, has gathered less than 2500 weapons.
