Father Of Three Cut Down

Tzion Busharian, 52, of the Shomron community of Mevo Dotan, was murdered Wednesday afternoon by terrorists on his way home. The Arab terrorists sprayed his car with dozens of bullets, but he still

managed to pull out his pistol and fire back until one bullet hit him in the head. Tzion is survived by his wife and three children, two of whom are soldiers.

Shmuel Elad, head of Mevo Dotan's local council, spoke with Arutz-7 about his fallen friend and his community: "Tzion was a founding and active member of Mevo Dotan, and a very dear friend. It's a very difficult loss... Unfortunately, this is our third such case. Hadas Abutbul was murdered over a year ago in the same place - and another woman was shot there a few months ago - and Tzvika Shelef was killed in June 2001 [in another drive-by shooting]. There is a path that leads from that spot directly to Jenin..." Asked about the security measures being taken, he said, "I can't say whether the army is working effectively enough or not, but the statistics speak for themselves. There have been three murders, so apparently more has to be done."

Praising Murderers

On March 11, 1978, Arabs led by a woman terrorist Dalal Mughrabi, hijacked an Israeli bus. The hijacking ended with 36 Israelis murdered. The large number of Israeli civilians killed turned this act of terror for Arabs into "one of the greatest successes of the struggle" and turned Dalal Mughrabi into the Arab's heroic, ideal woman: "Dalal is a symbol for the Palestinian nation." Mughrabi is honored in names of summer camps, schools and colleges, police and military courses. Annual ceremonies and TV broadcasts commemorate the day of her terror mission.

This week on the anniversary of her terror attack, the PA daily again wrote an article glorifying Dalal Mughrabi's mass murder.

The following is the text: "On the morning of March 11, a woman Palestinian fighter, Dalal Mughrabi, created a legend that would be taught for many years, when she and her unit infiltrated the Palestinian coastal plain near Tel Aviv causing tens of killed and injured, after taking Israeli passengers as hostages on a bus along the coastal highway. She and her unit opened fire at the military vehicles in the vicinity, resulting in hundreds of injuries among the occupying soldiers, especially because this highway is frequently used by military vehicles. The army, with the assistance of tanks and helicopters, pursued the bus until it was finally stopped near Herzliya. 25 years after this heroine's death as a *Shahida* [Dying for Allah], many Palestinian women are following in her footsteps every day. ...The present situation in the Middle East points to the immanence of Mashiach's coming as mentioned in the passage from the Yalkut Shimoni cited on several occasions previously. The "King of Persia" mentioned in that passage refers to present day Iraq. The "King of Aram" refers to the world's super-powers (for Aram is related to the word *rom* which means "uplifted"). Thus, the passage refers to a conflict between Iraq and all the other nations of the world. [A positive quality possessed by the super-powers results from the fact that one of them is allowing Jews to emigrate and live a life of freedom and, as a result, many Jews have emigrated to Eretz Yisrael.]
