The week in review

### Spring Cleaning

The Israeli army took out a top Hamas terrorist - Iyad Beck in downtown Gaza. No one else was hurt in the attack, though some sources say that a terrorist aide driving with him in the targeted car was wounded. Beck, a bodyguard of arch-terrorist Salah Shehadeh, who was similarly targeted and killed last July, was behind 18 attacks, in which 19 Israelis were killed. He was on the verge of committing additional attacks in the coming days, and once tried to put together an Al-Qaeda terrorist cell.

This killing is the latest in a series of IDF successes in its counter-terrorism war in Gaza. On Thursday, ground troops killed three wanted brothers who belonged to a Hamas cell that launched Kassam rockets and planned and committed suicide attacks against Israelis. Two days before that, Nidal Salameh, Khan Yunis

commander of the PFLP military wing, was killed in an IDF helicopter missile attack at his car. A Hamas terrorist was also killed in an exchange of fire with troops in Gaza.

Two leading members of the terrorist group closest to the PA leadership - the Al Aqsa Martyrs' Brigade - say that they will continue to use violence against Israelis.

### Saddam's Plan

American troops operating in Iraq discovered intelligence documents on Israel, including maps of the Knesset, Jerusalem, Dimona [where Israel's nuclear reactor is located] and other strategic information.

One map that was found by investigators depicted locations hit by Iraqi Scuds in the 1991 Gulf War. A female mannequin dressed in an IDF uniform was also discovered according to the New York Times report, as was detailed information of Israeli army ranks and fine detail regarding strategic areas in Israel. The report containing information on Dimona was contained in a satellite photo of the nuclear reactor area.

### Children's Aid Association

In a candid interview this week on PA TV the Director of the Palestinian "Children's Aid Association", an agency whose function is to help children, stated that as education policy with other values, Palestinians teach their children to aspire to Death for Allah - Shahada.

The following is the text of the interview:

*The Interview:*

Journalist Samir Shahin:

"The children only wanted to leave [school] and throw stones at the Israeli soldier, and to reach Shahada [Death for Allah]. They aspired to Shahada as a first priority.

Moderator: Mrs. Firial, in your opinion, does the Palestinian child understand the concept of Shahada?

Firial Hillis, C.E.O. of the Palestinian "Children's Aid Association": "The concept of Shahada for him [the child] means belonging to the homeland, from a religious point of view. Sacrifice for his homeland. Achieving SHAHADA in order to reach Paradise and to meet his God. This is the best. We also teach our children to protect the homeland, belonging and to reach Shahada".
