The week in review

### On The Way To School

One teenager was buried Wednesday and another will be laid to rest Thursday after a suicide bomber killed them and himself a few hundred meters from Qalqiliya at a highway gas station inside the Green Line.

Witnesses said the assailant apparently carried the nail-studded bomb under a black leather jacket, which he wore zipped to the neck despite the sweltering weather. "I was hurled backward," said Rafael Somer, 15, who was lightly injured. "When I got up, I saw one of my friends without hands. Another friend was torn apart.

### The Capital Under Attack

Jerusalem was rocked by two terror attacks on Tuesday. In the first, a car bomb exploded opposite a shopping mall in the Talpiot commercial zone as people were making their way to work in the morning. A few hours later, in the early afternoon, a suicide bomber blew himself up next to an Egged bus on the other side of town at the French Hill intersection.

## PEOPLE of the BOOK

### "The Main Thing is Action"

The Rebbe constantly stresses that "the main thing is action." Of the thousands of public talks the Rebbe delivered, almost every one contains a practical lesson which can be derived from the subject matter. If this is the case as a general rule, then all the more so is it the case concerning an issue such as the integrity of the Land of Israel, about which many people ask themselves, what can and should be done to improve the security of Israel, and those who dwell there.

### Gathering Children — Especially at Holy Places

On the Eve of Shavuot, 5733 (1973 — four months before the outbreak of the Yom Kippur War), the Rebbe issued an appeal to ensure that during the upcoming summer holidays each Jewish child should receive a Torah education. The stress was placed on the small and very small children. As a reason for his call, the Rebbe quoted the verse in Psalms, "From the mouths of babies and infants You have established power because of Your tormentors, to stay the enemy and avenger." *to be continued.....*

A total of 35 people were wounded - one seriously, one moderately, and the rest lightly - in the blasts that struck southern and northern Jerusalem within six hours of each other, as the Arab League summit got under way in Amman.

### All In A Days Work

When Drs. Pearl Hirshkowitz and Rachel Zomer were 'beeped' and instructed to immediately respond to their respective hospital emergency rooms, they learned their sons were among the attack victims scheduled to arrive.

A short time following the suicide terrorist detonated an explosive device near Moshav N'vei Yamin at 7:27am Wednesday morning, Petach Tikvah's Beilinson Hospital and nearby Sharon Hospital sent out a general pager alerts to physicians on 'stand-by,' ordering them to report to the hospitals at once.

Among the wounded were Netanel Hirshkowitz, 16, and Raphael Zomer, 14, sons of two of the doctors instructed to respond. The boys were not among those seriously injured and as such, were able to call their mothers from the ambulance and inform them of their condition to allay their fears

## STUFF you should know

### Infant's Father Explains

Prime Minister Ariel Sharon called the parents of Shalhevet Pass last night and asked them not to delay her funeral any longer. Shalhevet was the ten-month-old baby who was murdered in cold blood by a Palestinian sniper on Monday afternoon, and her parents refuse to bury her



until the government orders the army to reconquer the Abu Sneineh hills in Chevron. These hills overlook Jewish neighborhoods, and have been used for months as a base for shooting attacks

against Jews. Shalhevet's father, Yitzchak, who was wounded in the fatal attack, told Sharon that he would not accede to the request until Sharon gives the above order. A short time afterwards, the Avraham Avinu neighborhood was attacked by terrorist gunfire once again from the Shalhevet (Abu Sneineh) Hills. Chevron resident Moshe Ben-Zimra explained today, "Bodies are sometimes used for science and for other uses. This is a much more important issue. People's lives are at stake. If those hills are not retaken, other Jewish babies, children, and adults of Chevron are in danger of being shot to death from there."

"When they gave away Chevron," Pass continued, "we all said that it was just a matter of time before the Arabs use their towering height advantage over us and start shooting. Over the last six months they have shot thousands of bullets. We have had many miracles, but these apparently stopped with our baby... When a husband sees his wife pick up her baby and have the baby die from a bullet wound in her arms, the only thing we can think about is to make sure that no one else ever goes through this again !
