The week in review

Desecration Continues

Arabs shouting "Itbach el Yahud!" ("Slaughter the Jews!") have once again entered the Joseph's Tomb complex and desecrated the holy area situated inside the PA-controlled area of Shechem.

According to the Oslo Agreement and all agreements signed since then, Joseph's Tomb remains under exclusive Israeli control, as it is a Jewish holy site. The previous administration of Ehud Barak ordered a retreat under fire from the site, creating a situation of de facto PA control.

Rocket Hit The Capital

A 60 mm mortar rocket landed in a yard of a home on HaChavush Street in Jerusalem's Gilo neighborhood on Tuesday. There were no injuries but there was property damages to homes and glass.

More Rockets

A mortar rocket was fired at Kibbutz Nahal Oz Wednesday.

Ongoing Warfare

Soldiers positioned in the Gush Katif district of Gaza were attacked with anti-tank grenades near Gadid on Wednesday night before midnight.

Military positions in the southern Gaza community of N'vei Dekalim were also attacked by gunfire.

Miracle In Kiryat Arba

A bomb exploded Monday afternoon in a Kiryat Arba car, minutes after Chevron resident Elisheva Federman and her child left the vehicle.

UN And Hizbullah

Another videotape related to the kidnapping of the three Israeli soldiers in Lebanon - this one of the kidnapping itself - has now been reported to exist. Hizbullah's TV station reported Saturday night that the terrorist organization videotaped the October 2000 abduction. The UN continues to refuse to provide Israel with an unedited copy of a tape it has of the scene of the crime. Not a sign of life has been had from the three soldiers, nor from the fourth Israeli, Elchanan Tenenbaum, since the four were abducted nine months ago.

Peace Of Oslo

Following are facts pertaining to the Oslo War presented to the Knesset Foreign Affairs & Defense Committee on Tuesday by the GSS (General Security Service).

Since the start of the June 13 US-brokered cease-fire, there have been over 500 documented attacks.

Israeli Fatalities & Casualties

- 136 innocent persons have been killed
- 1,338 have been wounded
- 55 of the fatalities were inside Green Line Israel
- 38 of the fatalities were soldiers or members of Israeli security forces

PA Fatalities & Casualties

- 531 persons were killed
- 129 of the fatalities were members of PA security forces
- 94 were aligned with the Islamic Jihad & Hamas
- 89 were aligned with the Fatah & Tanzim terrorists
- 17 were aligned with resistance organizations

Facts Since Sept 13, 1993 Signing Of Oslo

- 85 suicide bombers since the Oslo signing
- 67 of the 85 suicide attacks were perpetrated
- 18 of the bombs were detonated in controlled explosions by security forces

The suicide terrorist profile is that of a university student with the majority of suicide bombers to date have been affiliated with Anajah University in Shechem.

Obligation To Settle The Land Part II

In an address on Pesach *Sheini*, 5738 (1978), the Rebbe said that there is an immediate need to populate the entire eastern border of the Holy Land, adding: "This is literally a matter of security for three-and-a-half million Jews!"

The Rebbe always mentioned in his addresses the saying of the Sages, "Action is the main thing." He also mentions this saying in connection with the indivisibility of the Land of Israel, which is an important and fateful issue. In his public address of 13 Tishrei 5738 (1977), the Rebbe stresses that action is the main thing with regard to the integrity of the land.

The entire Land of Israel should be populated, along its entire boundaries. This is similar to that which is said regarding Torah and *mitzvos* — just as we must perform the actual physical act, so must it be regarding the integrity of the Land of Israel — the physical act is necessary: to settle the entire Land of Israel!
