Crime...

Two Arab terrorists, driving slowly along a busy street in downtown Hadera Sunday afternoon, opened fire at Israelis on both sides of the street, killing 4. Policemen who arrived on the scene within minutes shot the attackers and killed them. Four Israelis were very seriously wounded, and several others are listed in moderate-to-serious condition; 44 people were injured in all, including more than 25 being treated for shock. The Islamic Jihad claimed responsibility for the attack.

...And Punishment

Despite the grave attacks on Sunday in Israel, the IDF withdrew its forces Sunday night from Bethlehem and Beit Jala, south of Jerusalem. The move is widely assumed to be the result of American pressure. Israeli and Palestinian security representatives, as well as CIA personnel, will meet today to coordinate further measures.

...Strengthen All Aspects Of Their Security And Defences

PA Cops At Work

Two terrorists that were killed by the IDF, after they opened fire on a Jewish motorist in the Shomron near Chomesh on Wednesday afternoon, have been identified as members of the PA paramilitary police force. The two were known to be affiliated with the Tanzim faction of the Fatah terror organization.

Terror Continues

Wednesday, in N'vei Dekalim, mortar and anti-tank grenades were fired at the industrial zone. And in Chevron, soldiers were attacked with hand grenades.

Buses For Peace

As a result of the increase in the number of shooting attacks on the Jordan Valley road over the past year, Defense Minister Binyamin Ben-Eliezer ordered bulletproof buses used on lines traveling the road, as is the case throughout Yesha areas.

Over the past weeks, six bulletproof buses have been placed into service on the Jordan Valley road by the Egged bus cooperative. The new buses are servicing routes between the capital, Tiberias and Kiryat Shmona in the north.

Supporting Terror

On October 30, four days before an economic conference on the Middle East was due to open at Palma de Majorca, Germany announced it was transferring 250 million Deutschmarks to the Palestinian Authority. It may therefore be of interest, particularly before British prime minister Tony Blair calls on Arafat, to find out how the Middle East economy looks from the perspective of the Palestinian hub town of Ramallah, in light of new discoveries revealed to DEBKAFfile, by high-placed intelligence sources.

On October 22, when Israeli forces burst into the Ramallah headquarters of Yasser Arafat's presidential guard known as Force 17, they found an extraordinary set of documents containing proof that the Palestinian leader was funding the entire body of Tanzim-Fatah terrorists directly from his own "presidential" budget.

The figures were there in black and white. Every one of the 10,000 Tanzim Terrorist were being paid 875 New Israeli Shekels - and have been doing so ever since the Palestinian leader launched his armed confrontation against Israel last September.
