The week in review

Victims Of Oslo

Thursday night, a terrorist entered a catering hall in Hadera, Armed with a M-16 automatic rifle, and hand grenades, opened fire at the guests attending a bat mitzvah celebration.

The terrorist's weapon jammed for a brief period, and the guests, began throwing tables, chairs, and bottles at the terrorist. He was forced out towards the lobby of the hall, and was shot dead by police that were arriving. Six persons were killed and over 30 wounded.

PA Forces Supervises Murder

An American born Israeli man, about 70, was murdered by gunfire in PA-controlled Beit Jala Tuesday today while PA security forces looked on without making any effort to intervene to save the innocent man's life. Eyewitnesses near the checkpoint have reported observing the PA forces, as they made no effort to react.

It is believed the victim entered the PA area to purchase building supplies for a home he was building in Har Gilo. His lifeless body was found in his car, also

exhibiting signs of having endured physical abuse or the like.

Israeli officials received at least one report of from eyewitnesses who saw the male in life-threatening danger. IDF officers immediately notified the PA but it appears absolutely nothing was done to extricate the male from the hands of the terrorists unharmed.

Racial Profiling

Prior to opening fire with automatic weapons at the car near Givat Ze'ev on Tuesday night, the two terrorists approached a different side of the white Fiat Uno and spoke with Yoela Chen and her aunt, Rachel Heini. Authorities explain this was to make certain the intended victims were Jews. Only then did they open fire, spraying the car's windshield with bullets.

Yoela, 45, the mother of two and a Givat Ze'ev resident, was hit in her head and upper thorax. She died on the scene a short time later. Rachel, 70, was hit in her chest and remains hospitalized in Jerusalem's Hadassah Hospital, listed in moderate condition.

Authorities believe the terrorists fled the scene on foot, heading to nearby el-Jib and from there, by car to PA-controlled Ramallah. The manhunt failed to locate the terrorists.

The government however must realize that it is essential that the physical, the military struggle, be accompanied by a sane national policy of information - to tell our people, and the rest of the world, at every step of the way, the whys and the wherefores of our existence, our actions and our beliefs.
