Who Can You Trust

An investigation into the January 27 suicide bombing in downtown Jerusalem that claimed the life of 81-year-old Israeli Pinchas Tokatli reveals that the female terrorist entered the city inside an Arab Red Crescent Society ambulance. The IDF and the GSS (Shin Bet) believe that the Fatah terrorist, 27-year-old Wafa Idris, who was a Red Crescent volunteer, passed through the Kalandia checkpoint north of the capital in the ambulance. The IDF says that this is not the first time that Red Crescent vehicles have been used by Arabs in weapons smuggling or hiding terrorists wanted by Israel.

Supporting The Terrorist

On The Way To Jerusalem

Bomb squad technicians have safely detonated a bomb being carried by a would-be suicide bomber on the Maale Adumim – Jerusalem road Wednesday afternoon. The bomb was detonated under controlled conditions in an isolated area. It was described as very powerful.

Fare Treatment Of Prisoners

Before the Israeli air strike on Nablus, Palestinian wardens released 25 Hamas and Islamic Jihad prisoners to get them out of harm's way, while 103 suspected informers for Israel remained in custody.

Impersonating The IDF

At 7:30 PM Wednesday night, an Arab wearing an IDF uniform and armed with an M-16 rifle and a grenade infiltrated the Jordan Valley agricultural community of Hamra, murdered three Jews and injured five others. The three fatalities, Miri Ochana, 45, her 11-year-old daughter Yael, and IDF First Sergeant Moshe Makonan Majus, 33. The terrorist entered the community near the hothouses and opened fire at a security patrol killing Majus, a Jewish immigrant from Ethiopia.

Buckling Under Pressure Brings To More Pressure

As to the explanation (of the Likud) that the only matter under discussion is the limited self-rule, whereby the Arabs will be in charge of their own education and agriculture etc. but not foreign affairs and security, and that this is only a trial period... these are all matters of diplomacy and I shall not argue with you on this, as it seems that you understand more on diplomacy than I. Is Iran Mixing In

An IDF reserve unit seized eight Kassam-2 rockets, warheads, and launchers on a truck departing from the West Bank city of Nablus on Wednesday. The rockets were destined for Hamas Terrorist in the Jenin refugee camp and were most likely going to be deployed against Afula and other Israeli communities in the Jezreel Valley, military sources said.

The capture marked the first time Israel has confirmed presence of such rockets in the West Bank.

The Kassam-2 was developed by Hamas, with technology it received from Iran, according to Ynet. According to the IDF, the 1.2-meter (5 feet) long missile has a range of 10-12 kilometers (6-7 miles) and can carry a 4-6 kilogram (8.8-13.2 pound) warhead, capable of inflicting serious damage. The army believes that Kassam-2 rockets have already been smuggled into Tulkarm and Kalkilya, which would put major Israeli cities such as Hadera and Kfar Saba in striking distance. Hamas reportedly conducted a successful test launch of the rocket several weeks ago near Nablus.

IDF Head of Command in Judea and Samaria Brig.-Gen. Gershon Yitzhak said at a press conference held to display the captured missiles. "If this warhead hit a crowded civilian area, it would cause many casualties."
