Another Day At Work

Egged bus driver Shalom Deri, 30, was recognized for his heroism. It was on Tuesday at 5:15pm; on the No. 961 bus from Jerusalem to Tiberias that Shlomo became suspicious of a male attempting to get on the bus near the Jordan Valley community of Mechola.

After the terrorist reached the second step, Deri got out of his seat, shouting, "He is a terrorist," prompting many passengers to flee via the rear door. Deri managed to push the terrorist outside the bus and close the door. It was then that the bomb was detonated. There were no injuries to innocent persons.

Rockets Continue To Fall

Tuesday Four Kassam rockets were fired into Israel. There were no injuries or damage. Officials indicated the rockets were fired from a distance of five kilometers (three miles).

Standing Firm

PA security chief Toufiq Tirawi has stated that Abu Gholmi, Basel Asmar and Hamdi Koran, wanted for the October 2001 murder of Minister of Tourism Rechavam Ze'evi, are indeed in custody. He added there was "no chance" that any of them would be turned over to Israel to stand trial.

PA Intelligence At Work

The investigation into the fatal shooting attack in Ein Arik that claimed the lives of six soldiers has revealed that one of the terrorists involved was a former member of PA intelligence services. Investigators indicated they would not be surprised if the Tanzim terrorists responsible for the attack were also ties to PA forces.

Life In Chevron

Terrorists have resumed shooting into the Jewish Quarter of Chevron Tuesday from Givat HaShalhevet (Abu Sneineh). There where no reports of injuries.

Chevron community leaders report gunfire hit the playground area, fortunately missing the civilians in the area.

Drivers Beware

Israel Police on Thursday afternoon published a warning to citizens that persons in the PA are working to kidnap an Israeli citizen. The warning is directed specifically at persons whose vehicle was recently stolen.

Police explain that the elements inside the PA will most likely contact the victim of a car theft, offering to return the vehicle for payment, enticing the owner to come to a seam line area to close the deal. At that time, the kidnapping would be actualized.

Police are urging anyone whose vehicle was stolen recently make contact with them, adding the ban on entering any PA autonomous areas remains in effect.

The police warning is based on intelligence community information received by the department's Shai (Shomron-Yehuda) district.
