Jerusalem Under Attack

Terrorists from Beit Jala fired into Gilo for over eight hours, on Thursday placing the southern Jerusalem neighborhood under siege. Four people were wounded and 40 homes damaged as a result of the gunfire.

With Friends Like These...

Despite the reported increase in anti-Semitic attacks in France since the start of the Oslo War, French President Chirac said France isn't anti-Semitic and there wasn't an increase in attacks as reported.

Chirac told FM Shimon Peres that the reports in the Israeli media were untrue, adding that he was shocked over the reports, insisting his country was not anti-Semitic and attacks against Jews and Jewish institutions were not on the rise.

Peres responded by explaining from his part, France has not been and is not today an anti-Semitic country.

In Arafat We Trust?

At a high level "Security" meeting with Israelis, PA and US observers. It was agreed to permit the PA to deal with the security issues, while Israeli officials reiterated they would operate when necessary in the absence of PA action.

Israeli Arabs

A female suicide bomber perpetrated an attack at the Maccabim Checkpoint on Route 443, between Modi'in and Jerusalem, Wednesday night.

A vehicle carrying three Arabs approached a checkpoint. A female got out of the vehicle with a bomb strapped to her. Border police manning the checkpoint at that point discerned something was about to happen, and distanced themselves as they reacted, accounting for the relatively light injuries.

Two of the three terrorists involved in the attack were Israeli Arab citizens. The third was a PA resident. The female suicide bomber was killed when she detonated the explosive device against border police. The other two terrorists were killed by police gunfire as they tried to flee the scene.

Who Is Paying?

Abu Ala (Mahmoud Qurei), whom Yasser Arafat has mentioned as his choice to succeed him as head of the Palestinian Authority, built himself a \$1.5 million vacation home - from money that came from the international aid provided to the Palestinian Authority. So said IDF Coordinator in Judea and Samaria Gen. Amos Gilad last night, in an address to a group of Jewish veterans from abroad on a solidarity visit to Israel. Gilad said that cash given by the U.S., Germany and other countries "personally enriches PA seniors and deepens the corruption in the PA." He said that abuse of the money by public figures greatly angers much of the Palestinian public and leads to a loss of trust in the Palestinian leadership. Gilad also noted that the cash is often used for buying weapons, and recommended that the foreign aid be directed towards projects that would help the entire PA public.
