### Four More Weeks

Army Chief of Staff Lt.-Gen. Shaul Mofaz told army reservists that the IDF recommended continuing Operation Defensive Shield for another four weeks to achieve the desired results. Mofaz explained that while a great deal was accomplished during the operation, an additional four weeks would have resulted in a significant difference, especially regarding intelligence gathering, arrests of terrorists, and the confiscation of weapons.

The army commander told the reservists that unfortunately, the government decided not to go with the army's recommendation.

### Europe Has A Friend

Foreign Minister Shimon Peres stated on Tuesday that "Europe is not anti-Semitic but there is anti-Semitism in Europe".

### UN At It Again

The United Nations Security Council announced that it is very concerned for Yasser Arafat's well being as a result of the ongoing IDF presence around Arafat's Mukata headquarters in Ramallah and the ongoing Israeli imposed isolation on the PA leader.

### "It's Not My Priority"

PA security chief Jibril Rajoub stated on Monday that security cooperation with Israel was a thing of the past.

"I don't think its possible for us, to talk about security coordination or any kind of coordination with Israel. It's over," stated Rajoub. When asked about stopping terrorist attacks targeting Israelis he commented, "It's not my priority".

### War At A Price

Egyptian Prime Minister said his country would go to war with Israel if Arab countries stumped up \$100 billion to pay for the confrontation. "If you want to undertake an action and be ready to face up to challenges, you need at least \$100 billion"

### Just As The Army Stood On The Verge Of Total Victory

Since then the situation has, if anything, worsened. The Israel Defense Forces, with their usual bravery and self-sacrifice in defense of their brethren, have succeeded in cleaning out the terrorists from much of Lebanon, and have encircled Beirut where 6000 terrorists are trapped. ### Is Texas Boycotting Israel?

A authorized General Motors dealer in Texas, Texas Automotive Export, sent a fax to an Israeli client, Avi Udiz, that the company is unwilling to sell him the parts he was seeking for his Isuzu jeep because at present, they are not dealing with Israelis. The fax stated the response was a decision taken due to Israel's actions vis-à-vis the PA. The fax was signed by company representative John Harris, who called on Udiz to pressure his country to "stop the offensive on the Palestinian people," adding that "your country has lost the respect of the civilized world".

The alarmed client sent letters and copies of the fax to the Prime Minister's Office, the Foreign Ministry, and other official offices, telling Israel Radio on Wednesday morning that has also been contacted by journalists in the US seeking to publicize his story.
