The week in review

Premature Explosion

Wednesday the IDF reported that a suicide bomber was killed by an apparent premature explosion of the bomb he was carrying, northwest of PA-controlled Jenin, in an area under Israeli security control.

On his body soldiers found a bomb, components for another device, a pistol fitted with a telescopic sight and remains of a LAW shoulder-held missile.

A Watchful Eye

An alert security guard at the Barbie Club in southern Tel Aviv saved many lives Thursday by opening fire at the bomber's vehicle.

The security guard at the nightclub, spotted the terrorist's vehicle and opened fire, leading to the explosion. The Police found one body on the scene, presumably that of the bomber.

Magen David Adom emergency medical service officials report two persons were transported from the scene to Ichilov Hospital, one listed as light-to-moderate and the second being treated for hysteria.

There were hundreds of persons in the club at the time of the blast.

Major Disaster Averted

A major disaster was averted Thursday, when a bomb planted underneath the carriage of a fuel tanker exploded at the Pi Gililot petroleum and gas depot in Herzliya. As a result of the blast, a small fire broke out but was quickly doused by the depot's automatic fire extinguisher system. The driver of the tanker was not in the vehicle at the time. Efforts in the past to move the fuel depot away from residential areas have not been successful.

The blast occurred when the tanker arrived at the depot to fill up. Police and depot officials initially believed the explosion occurred due to a malfunction in the transfer of fuel. Upon investigation, police discovered the remnants of a cellular phone and traces of explosives under the truck.

STUFF you should know

Phased Plan

Yasser Arafat has never been less than clear about his goals -- at least not in Arabic. On the very day that he signed the Oslo accords in 1993 -- in which he promised to renounce terrorism and recognize Israel, he addressed the Palestinian people on Jordanian television and declared that he had taken the first step "in the 1974 plan." This was a thinly veiled reference to the "phased plan," according to which any territorial gain was acceptable as a means toward the ultimate goal of Israel's destruction.

Faisal al-Husseini, a leading PA spokesman, made the same point in 2001 when he declared that the West Bank and Gaza represented only "22 percent of Palestine" and that the Oslo process was a "Trojan Horse." He explained, "When we are asking all the Palestinian forces and factions to look at the Oslo Agreement and at other agreements as 'temporary' procedures, or phased goals, this means that we are ambushing the Israelis and cheating them." The goal, he continued, was "the liberation of Palestine from the river to the sea," i.e., the Jordan River to the Mediterranean Sea -- all of Israel.

Victory Comes From G-D Part II

...It is thus necessary for the soldiers to have absolute trust in "the L-rd, G-d of Hosts." This trust is achieved by strengthening their bond with Judaism, to the extent of full observance of Torah and *mitzvos* in daily life. Moreover, each soldier in the Israel Defense Forces should possess a letter inscribed in his merit in one of the *Sifrei Torah* currently being written to unite all Jewry. There are 304,805 letters in a *Sefer Torah*; and when a Jewish soldier has a letter inscribed in a *Sefer Torah* in his merit, an eternal bond is formed between him and the other Jews in the *Sefer Torah*. Thus, when a Jewish soldier goes into battle, he does not go alone, but together with 304,804 Jews. Naturally, this assures complete victory.

Today, in the time of exile, it is G-d's will that we must resort to natural means — physical weapons — to ensure the safety of Jews in our Holy Land. But when we fight in the name of G-d, when we act as true Jews in our daily lives, we will not even need to use them, for then "all the nations of the earth shall see that the Name of the L-rd is called upon you and they shall fear you."
