The week in review

PA Security = Terror

PA security chief Toufiq Tirawi is directly connected to terror attacks according to Shin Bet officials. One prisoner in custody has detailed how Tirawi supplied him with a Kalashnikov AK-47 assault rifle, ammunition, and orders to carryout an attack.

Prisoner Isa Jabarin explained to investigators that he was ordered in March to carryout a shooting attack inside Green Line Israel by Tirawi.

Terror Avoided in Chevron

Army forces operating in Yatah Sunday night, in the Hevron district, apprehended Osama Salahat, an Islamic Jihad suicide bomber who was planning an attack. He was turned over to the custody of the Shin Bet.

Seeking New Partner

Foreign Minister Shimon Peres announced Monday that Israel must seek a new partner to replace Yasser Arafat. Peres made his comments during the Labor party committee meeting in Tel Aviv, explaining that after the US declared Arafat is not the partner who will bring a peace agreement to the PA, Israel must seek another partner.

North Under Attack

A resident of Kfar Yuval was injured by the explosion of anti-aircraft fire from southern Lebanon Monday afternoon. A shell landed near his home. He was taken to a Kiryat Shmona medical facility for primary treatment.

Facing Reality

Monday, IDF Chief of Staff Shaul Mofaz stated the IDF must prepare for the next war, as if it is unavoidable.

Mofaz served with three governments and for 36 years in the IDF.

PA vs. USA

Yasser Arafat's Fatah terrorist organization is signed on posters disseminated publicly throughout Judea, Samaria and Gaza that threaten terrorism against Americans. The posters say that the attacks will take place if the U.S. continues to support Israel and call for Arafat's removal.

Hamas is more practical-minded in its anti-Americanism. The IDF Spokesman reports that the official Hamas website recently hosted an electronic chat in which at least four participants offered a fifth user advice on how to murder Americans.

Excerpts:

"Once a week, a group of American "dogs" come near us on the sea front. I have been following them for a long time and am interested in your suggestions for ways to get rid of them secretly."

"If they arrive in a private car, put a large amount of sugar in the gas tank of the car. Then, you can ambush them on the way back because the car will get stuck in the way. You will have many options to get rid of them. You can run them over on the road, after they abandon the broken down car. You can put a trap on the beach if they tend do a lot of walking. If you have people with you and four cars, you can stop them at a certain point on the road, at a traffic light for example, block them from all directions and burn them in their cars using a Molotov cocktail."

We Can Only Imagine

This is the clear *halachah* in *Shulchan Aruch*. Even a cursory look at the situation today in Eretz Yisroel will reveal the startling similarity to this *halachah*. The essence of the above *halachah* is the prohibition against allowing non-Jews to take control of a city next to the border for fear it will imperil the security of the country itself. This is exactly the situation today. Every inch of territory in Eretz Yisroel today contributes to its security; and to give it to non-Jews endangers that security. The *unanimous* opinion of military experts is that the lands are essential to Eretz Yisroel's security, and to relinquish them poses a *military danger* to its very existence. The reason is simple. Strategic depth is vital to its security, as was so clearly demonstrated in the 1973 Yom Kippur War. We can only imagine what would have happened, G-d forbid, had Egypt been in possession of the Sinai; the Egyptian army could have easily penetrated to the very core of Eretz Yisroel. Yehudah and Shomron and the Golan Heights are even more vital for defensible borders; and to relinquish them outright, or in the form of autonomy which is the equivalent of giving them up, is endangering our security. All these lands are, in the words of *Shulchan Aruch*, "close to the border," meaning that giving possession of them to the enemy is leaving the rest of the land vulnerable to easy conquest.
