The week in review

8 Vote For Terror

The Knesset passed a law Monday, preventing family members of Arab terrorists, with citizenship, from receiving National Insurance Institute (NII) payments. Until now, dependents of terrorists who were killed in "the act" were entitled to receive monthly stipends from the State of Israel.

The law, proposed by MK Tzvi Hendel, was introduced following the September 9, 2001 suicide bombing perpetrated by Israeli Arab Muhammad Shakhher Hebeishi. Hebeishi detonated his explosives at the Nahariyah train station, murdering three. His family currently receives a monthly NII payment.

The law passed by a vote of 22-8 and was backed by Prime Minister Ariel Sharon and other government ministers.

Keeping The Lid On Terror

Tuesday, IDF's Chief of Staff, Lt.-Gen. Moshe Yaalon explained to the Knesset Foreign Affairs and Defense Committee,

why the army must remain in Judea and Samaria "Our presence in the villages and cities [Judea and Samaria] is like a blanket over a fire... There exists the ability and motivation to initiate terrorism... If we take away the blanket, the fire will burst forth..."

When the committee's new Chairman, MK Chaim Ramon, said that Israel must not "re-conquer the area," and that the Arabs of Yesha will "find it difficult to come to peace from a position of defeat," Yaalon responded, "The Arabs understood Israel's departure from Lebanon as a weakness of Israeli society that does not know how to make sacrifices. This is why it is so important to prove that they will gain nothing via terrorism."

Impersonating The IDF

Tuesday, 9 Israelis were murdered and 19 wounded, when at least 3 Arab terrorists dressed as Israeli soldiers detonated a roadside bomb alongside a public bus, near the Shomron community of Emmanuel, 20 miles east of Tel Aviv. After the initial blast, fleeing passengers were greeted by a barrage of short range gunfire from the terrorists who emerged from hiding. The Arabs also targeted passing civilians cars. The wounded were taken to hospitals in the Greater Tel Aviv area.

Because of this deep-seated hatred, there are many Arabs willing to engage in terrorist activity against Israel.
