The week in review

### Easing Restrictions

Defense Minister, Binyamin Ben-Eliezer ordered a further lifting of restrictions on PA residents, primarily issuing additional permits to allow travel of laborers from one PA area to another.

### And The Result

The IDF commander in Judea and Samaria said, Thursday morning, that the Arabs who lynched the Israeli in the industrial zone near Tul Karem, took advantage of today's decision to temporarily lift the closure on PA cities. While the Israeli lifted the closure to allow Arab residents to purchase supplies, the terrorists used the time to search out a Jewish victim.

In response to the analysis, Rabbi Yitzchak Levy, of the National Religious Party (NRP), said, "The easing of restrictions are misused and contribute nothing to calming the situation." According to the NRP leader, "There is no place for easing restrictions in the midst of a terrorist assault, especially when such measures are used for murdering Jews."

### Our Right to the Land of Israel

### Enemy Amongst Us

An Israeli-Arab from Jaffa, accused of driving two suicide terrorists to their double attack in Tel Aviv two weeks ago, has been arrested. The two originally wanted to blow themselves up in very crowded areas, but could not find any - as it was the fast of Tisha B'Av, and public eateries and places of entertainment were closed. The terrorists then directed the driver - who says their threats to blow up in the car intimidated him from calling the police - to drive towards the area of the old central bus station. The terrorists detonated themselves there, amidst a crowd of foreign workers and others; five people were killed in the blast, including two workers from China and one from Romania.

### Killing The Dead

A violent exchange took place between Arabs and Jews in Chevron, Sunday, as mourners gathered to bury slain IDF Sgt. Elazar Leibovitz. Arabs murdered Leibovitz at the Zief junction near Chevron on Friday.

As the funeral procession left the Cave of the Patriarchs (Me'arat HaMachpela), on its way to the town's ancient Jewish cemetery, Arabs standing on the roofs and balconies of their homes nearby began heaving cement blocks, boulders, planks and iron rods down onto the mourners.

## STUFF you should know

### A Month Of Terror

- July 9** - Terrorist opened fire at police in Jerusalem's Old City. One passerby was murdered and one officer wounded.
- July 10** - An IDF officer was killed by terrorist gunfire in southern Gaza.
- July 16** - Terrorists dressed in IDF uniforms detonated roadside bombs, fired automatic weapons and threw grenades at a bus traveling from Bnei Brak to Emanuel. Nine people murdered and over 20 injured.
- July 17** - IDF officer was killed by terrorist gunfire, during a manhunt for terrorists, three other soldiers were wounded.
- July 17** - Suicide bombers detonated explosive devices at a crowd in Tel Aviv. Five people murdered and over 30 injured.
- July 25** - Terrorists fired at a vehicle traveling in the Shomron. One man was killed and a passenger moderately wounded.
- July 26** - Terrorists open fire at a vehicle in the Chevron Hills, one person murdered.
- July 26** - Terrorist target a family traveling to the Chevron Hills for Shabbos. The parents and one of their children were murdered, nine children were left orphaned.
- July 30** - Terrorists fired at 2 fuel merchants (brothers) in the Shomron, killing them.
- July 31** - Bomb exploded in the Café on Jerusalem's Hebrew University campus, seven persons were murdered and 86 injured. 30 people were murdered during the month of July by PLO terror.
